In these last few weeks of school, keep the following information in mind for your student.

ALL FM, ROGER, AND SOUNDFIELD EQUIPMENT MUST BE TURNED IN BEFORE SUMMER BREAK! 😊

- Please do not send equipment home with your student (except of course for their personal hearing aids or cochlear implants!). Microphones, transmitters, and speakers need to be returned to the Audiologist. Everything *should* be collected by the Educational Audiologist or DHH Itinerant Teacher before the last day of school.
